- Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

No special qualifications are needed and the most important thing is to have a keen interest in the school and be prepared to play an active part in the governing body's work. However, we would particularly welcome nominations from parents with skills in finance. Training is available for all governors and this governing body has an expectation that those new to being a governor, attend free induction training

School Dinners


