Notes for your diary

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back.

It is lovely to see the children in their summer uniforms.

Our building work is steaming ahead! All work planned for the holiday was completed and really good progress is being made. It is great for the children to be able to see how our school is being developed. The contractors 'Built off Site' will lead assemblies for the children at key points throughout the programme.

Safeguarding

In line with safeguarding procedures we have drawn up a **Code of Conduct for Parents, Carers and visitors to the school**. This has been agreed by our Governing Body and follows LA guidelines. School meals this half term – Year 3 to 6

Lewisham Council have advised us that the cost of school meals will increase to £2.10 per day with effect from 1st May.

The amount for next half term will be £55.90 – calculated as follows £16 (8 days at £2 per day) from **19th April until 28th April** plus £39.90 (19 days at £2.10 per day) from **2nd May until 26th May**.

School meals this term – Nursery

The amount for Nursery children who attend full-time will be £55.90 – calculated as follows £16 (8 days at £2 per day) from 19th April until 28th April plus £39.90 (19 days at £2.10 per day) from 2nd May until 26th May.

The amount for Nursery children who attend part-time will be as follows:

Full day Monday : £8.30

Full day Tuesday : £10.40

Full day Wed/Fri : £12.40

Please note that Nursery dinners can now be paid via ParentPay from April.
