Birthday Cakes and Edible Treats

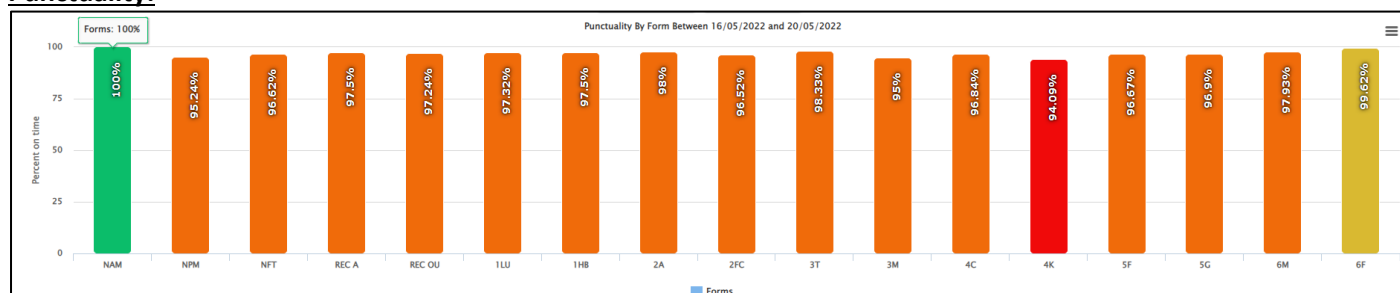
