

- List different ways in which you can empower your children to use technology safely and positively

Thank you to all of you who have downloaded the app! I was delighted to see how quickly the app was downloaded and was being used to contact the office. We now have 125 users, which is amazing!! If you have not downloaded the app, you should have all received an email with all the information, including a code which will expire after 60 days. If you cannot find it and wish to use the app, contact the office and we will be able to issue a new email.

This is a very quick and easy way to communicate directly with the office. All you need to do is download the app and use the code included in the email.
