We have finally got to the end of the spring term and the children are ready for a well-deserved holiday.

Last Friday, 12 of our Year 6 pupils took part in a 'Youth Sports Coach' training day. They then used their skills to run

activities for our Year 1 pupils. They did extremely well and all achieved their coaching qualification.

Tuesday Year 3 visited The Tate Modern Museum to look at representations of plants and flowers in art to enrich their science and art topics.

Year 6 pupils went to visit Northbrook park nature area to enrich their learning about plants. Also all our Reception pupils went to Manor House Gardens to look at our natural world.

Some of our 3 and 6 pupils went to our parish church to learn about the Stations of the Cross. We have also decided to take a class to church each week to join in with the parish morning mass. This will support the children in getting a deeper understanding of the Mass. We will let you know when your child's class is due to attend and you will be welcome to come with us if you wish.

Today we were visited by a teacher from CAFOD who led an Assembly for all our KS2 pupils. This focused on what we can do to reduce the effects of climate change. This really made an impact on our children and we will be looking at how we can do more in this area. One obvious way will be to look at reducing our use of plastic.


