Thank you supporting your child to use sustainable transport throughout October. Please encourage your child to return the record which they have been keeping so that I can sort out prizes.

If your child is cycling to school, please ensure that they wear a helmet as this could prevent a really serious head injury. Also, if your child cycles to school on his/her own, please insist that they come straight to school and go straight home at the end of the day. I have had reports of our pupils cycling around the estate, up and down grass banks, doing stunts and not showing awareness of danger from cars. Many of these pupils are also not wearing helmets.

You can make an appointment for a 10 minute discussion with your child's teacher. You will also be able to spend time looking at your child's work before your appointment if you arrive a bit earlier.

In order to ensure you don't have to wait, teachers will use timers. It is really important that appointments do not overrun but if you need more time then you are welcome to arrange a follow up meeting.

There will be crèche facilities during these meetings.
