**Maths**

Children will identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line. We will continue to compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100 and use  $<$ ,  $>$  and  $=$  sign. Children will compare and sequence intervals of time, tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times. They will gain confidence in understanding and knowing the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
