I am so sorry to inform you that we have been advised by Public Health England to close our school for the remainder of this term. A member of our office bubble has tested positive which means that all of our office staff will have to self isolate. We do not have the capacity to run the school safely without staff in our school office. There is no need for your child in Year 3, 4, 5 or 6 to self-isolate as they have not had direct contact with any member of staff who has tested positive.

I will be monitoring emails and calls throughout the holiday to ensure you are notified regarding any risks. If your child develops any key symptoms and tests positive it is really important that you contact me so I can minimise risks for our community and extended family members.
