### Food Bank

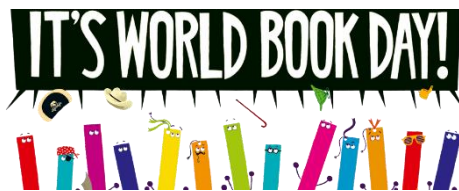
Our food bank has been a wonderful support for many of our families during very challenging times. It is currently quite depleted so any donations would be very welcome.
