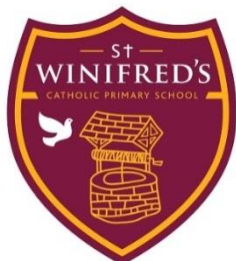

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have all had a really good week at school. The cold which was working its way around the school seems to be subsiding and attendance has greatly improved. We had a small number of pupils who took tests to be absolutely sure and all of these results were negative. Thank you so much for supporting us and keeping everyone safe.

I just wanted to clarify that if a pupil presents with a high temperature, a continuous cough or loss of smell or taste – they must stay home and take a test. They can only return when they have a negative result. Their siblings must also stay home and isolate even if they show no symptoms. If the child with symptoms does not take a test they must all stay home for 14 days. They cannot return to school when they are feeling better because we would not know if they did have COVID. If they did have COVID they would still spread this when their symptoms have gone. Taking a test helps us to be sure, to get pupils back to school and to keep everyone safe.
