KNOWLEDGE

- Learn about festivals, celebrations and cultural symbols associated with different faith traditions and cultural heritages including Spanish speaking ones.
- Identify some of the countries where spanish is spoken
- Use experience of patterns and sounds of language and link the spelling, sound and meaning of words
- Begin to use simple dictionaries to explore language.
- Begin to understand that in Spanish nouns have feminine and masculine forms.

Year 6 Knowledge and skills.

KNOWLEDGE

- Learn about the different languages spoken by the children in school and begin to identify the parts of the world where these languages are spoken
- Learn about festivals, celebrations and cultural symbols across the world
- Recognise and understand similarities and differences between people and places
- Draw on knowledge of word classes, letters and letter strings to help understanding of Spanish language
- Use dictionaries and knowledge of language to broaden vocabulary and develop ability to understand new words
- Use knowledge of sentence structure and basic grammar when reading or creating a sentence
- Know the gender of some common nouns.
- Begin to understand conjugation of high-frequency verbs

- Speak in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures
- Engage in conversations, asking and answering familiar questions
- Express opinions and respond to those of others
- Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes
- Present ideas and information orally to a range of audiences.
- Demonstrate appropriate pronunciation.
- Describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing
- Write phrases from memory and adapt these to create new sentences, to express ideas clearly
- Read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing
- Apply knowledge of grammar rules (noun gender) and verb conjugation to build sentences independently.
